KANSAS BASKETBALL BILL SELF TEAM CAMP JUNE 16th – 18th, 2017

Team Camp: The Bill Self Kansas Basketball Team Camp will take place Friday, June 16th through Sunday, June 18th. The camp is open to all high school teams. It is the premiere team camp in the Midwest and will provide an opportunity for campers to improve their skills while playing in organized games against great competition. The format for this camp will include round-robin games (pool play) and tournament play. Teams will be categorized into competitive divisions with each team guaranteed a minimum of six games.

Facilities: Camp games will be held in Historic Allen Fieldhouse; Kansas Basketball Practice Facility; Horejsi Family Athletics Center and the KU Rec Center - all on the KU campus. Additionally, we will also be using the new Sports Pavilion in Lawrence located at Rock Chalk Park which is approx. 6.6 miles from Allen Fieldhouse (15 min. drive).

Camp Staff: Bill Self and his staff will direct the camp. A certified medical trainer will be on site during camp at all times. Current and former Kansas basketball players will also participate in assisting the staff with camp. An officiating clinic sponsored by the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference will take place in conjunction with this camp.

Gear: Each participant will receive a reversible tank jersey. All coaches will receive a KU polo as a 'thank you' for attending. Additionally, the winners of each division will receive a t-shirt. Teams are responsible for bringing their own basketballs for warm-ups.

Housing: All boarding campers will be staying in our dorms, located on the KU campus, just a block away from Allen Fieldhouse. Each dorm room accommodates two campers. Each camper is responsible for his own bedding, pillow, towel and toiletries. The dorms will be supervised on Saturday night 9pm-12am by camp managers and counselors to allow the team coaches to attend a social with KU's coaches and staff. One coach is required to stay with the team overnight in the dorms. Two of your team coaches can stay in the dorm for free and any additional rooms for more than 2 coaches are \$50 per night.

Meals: Dinner will be provided Friday and Saturday evenings. Breakfast will be provided Saturday and Sunday mornings. Teams are responsible for lunches on Saturday and Sunday. A Lawrence restaurant guide will be provided at the camp orientation.

Medical: All campers must carry their own insurance. The parent/guardians personal or injury insurance policy will be utilized as the primary insurance for the treatment of injuries and hospitalization due to illness or injuries incurred during camp. Please be certain to complete and sign the parental consent form. The camper will not be allowed to participate in camp if this form is not signed or if a physical signed by a physician is not turned in. (This information and forms will be sent upon receipt of the initial team application form).

Registration/Confirmation:

- **To reserve your space in the Bill Self Kansas Basketball Team Camp, please complete and return the team camp application form.** (Space is limited).
- Upon receiving your team application, additional information will be sent to you, including your individual player application sheets, parental consent form, and medical form.
- In order to **finalize** a spot in team camp, a *minimum of 7* player application sheets and individual player fees must be returned by June 1st, 2016. **This will act as your non-refundable deposit.** (Max of 12 per team)
- Complete confirmation and information packets will be sent upon the receipt of the individual player applications and fees.
